

# Razz Poker Betting Structure

Playing Razz Poker game like any other poker play is playing against the dealer. Beating the dealer's hand every time one plays is very important in Razz poker game; however, unlike stud the play should be based on the low hand ranking and not the high card ranking.

While practicing Razz poker game, it is best advised to play the dealer button in a multi opponent game. Use the dealer button to start a new game of Razz Poker. Also play the role of second opponent at the same time, might seem complicated, but while playing in this way it will be best to play only with poker math and not tricks. By doing this for hundreds of table, the maximum probability of winning and beating the dealer every time can be mastered. After this, the next level will be for one to play an opponent in Razz poker game with the dealer being the computer. If one succeeds in beating the dealer most of the time, then the player has mastered the valuable kind of Razz poker game strategy and they can keep going with proceeding to higher levels of play with a complex high-skilled opponent table. Call the bets when the situation is quite clear that the dealer button can be beat, while making the call it should be noted that beating the dealer in Razz poker game is not beating the existing hand, but beating the hand that the dealer might possibly get in the next draw! If the call is going to be a maniac approach without enough funds to meet up with a possible bluff raise from the dealer, the player might be forced to go out of the table, call should be made with consideration to affordability of the chips. At the beginning of Razz Poker Game, one will be required to put up an ante, the amount to be put in ante appears on the ante box. Razz poker game software allows the players to increase or decrease the ante bet. The bet structure can be modified based on the interest of all the players that are interested to participate in the Razz poker game. Some Razz poker game guides or programs read the board cards against the card value that one holds and they show which combination of strategies should be used with respect to possible combination of cards that might be dealt next.
